SUBJECT: Response to House Armed Service: Committee Query on US-UK Memorandum of Understanding for Cooperation in R&D, Production and Procurement - ACTION MEMORANDUM

Dear Mr. Secretary:

I have reference to a "Memorandum of Understanding Between the Government of the United States and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland relating to the Principles Governing Cooperation in R&D, Production, and Procurement of Defense Equipment." This Memorandum of Understanding became effective on September 24, 1975, with the signatures of Mr. Schlesinger for the Government of the United States, and Mr. Mason for the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

Various representatives of labor and industry have contacted the Committee on Armed Services expressing their concern over the possible adverse implications of this agreement. Allegations have been made that among other things the effect of the agreement is to permit a blanket waiver of the provisions of the Buy American Act in respect to future off-shore procurements encompassed by the agreement. Furthermore, it is alleged that the absence of any publicized implementing documents places industry in an unfair competitive position in that, at the present time, it is not aware of the manner in which this agreement will actually be implemented in connection with specific solicitations made by the Department of Defense for research and development, production, or procurement of defense equipment.

In view of these circumstances, it is requested that you provide a comprehensive response to the general allegations and concerns expressed by labor and industry together with a review of the manner in which your
