MEMO FOR DR. WADE

SUBJECT: National Security Strategy Review

At OMB yesterday, SecDef discussed NSSMs and NSDMs -- and the fact that many are out of date -- with Lynn and Ogilvie. All agreed that it is time to turn to on a review and update.

In subsequent conversation with Scowcroft, SecDef proposed a Boverie-Wade-Aldridge-Ogilvie effort to:

- -- Go through NSSMs/NSDMs to decide which need redoing.
- -- Group them by priority ... perhaps, those on which we should get to work <u>now</u> and finish in 90 days, those by the end of the FY 78 budget cycle, and those by 30 June '77.
- -- Produce a "snapshot" of this sorting for early consideration, and make recommendations to SecDef (and Lynn and Scowcroft).
- -- Get as much done as possible within 90 days.

and to this end, Boverie will get in contact with you shortly. See NSC Staff Memo of 2 July (SecDef Cont Nr. X-1975) for openers.

Let's shoot for the preliminary snapshot by 24 July.
