The report you sent me on your latest NATO visit was interesting and informative. I had planned to discuss at the June DPC Ministerial a number of the issues which you had highlighted, and your report proved to be an excellent checklist. Your timely comments were useful in the preparation of the remarks which I made at the Ministerial.

I expressed to Defense Ministers my regret that progress had not been more impressive during the past year in flexibility, standardization and rationalization of NATO defenses. While acknowledging the real financial and political problems which exist, I urged my colleagues to accept the goal to make decisions by next December which would allow tactical communications systems to be interoperable. This is an area which you emphasized in your report.

I understand that Gene McAuliffe has already expressed our appreciation to you for sending us the report. However, I wanted to add my personal thanks.
