MEMORANDUM FOR The Secretary of Defense

SUBJECT: Hearing before the Subcommittee on Arms Control, Senate Committee on Armed Services

On June 2, 1976, Senator Jackson wrote to request your appearance before his Subcommittee on Arms Control on June 4. He indicated that the hearing would be in executive session and would deal with SALT in general, and with the press reports on compliance issues in particular. No formal statement is required.

On June 4, you wrote to Senator Jackson saying you were unable to appear on that day but would try to arrange a date following your return from Europe and Africa.

Subsequently, Senator Jackson's office has suggested the period July 20-22 for your appearance.

In the proposed letter to Senator Jackson, you offer to appear at that time.
