MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

SUBJECT: Visit of Danish MOD Møller to the US

As you know, Danish MOD Møller has been discussing with Admiral Kidd, SACLANT, a visit to the US during the last half of July.

The attached letter to MOD Møller, for your signature, would confirm your desire to meet with him during his visit and authorize DoD transportation for him within the US.

The itinerary Møller has discussed with Kidd includes time in Washington and Norfolk; visits to Danish (student) personnel at Redstone Arsenal, Ala.; Vance AFB, Okla.; Holloman AFB, N.M.; Fort Bliss, Texas; Williams AFB, Ariz.; and a day in Los Angeles.

When a firmer schedule has been arranged, we will propose a specific time for you to meet with Møller, perhaps including luncheon.

We would <u>anticipate arranging other meetings for Møller at the Pentagon</u> as well. He would also be amenable to our altering his proposed itinerary to include other DoD facilities of Danish interest, such as Wright-Patterson AFB to discuss the F-16.

Recommend you sign the attached letter. We will then designate one of the Services as Executive Agent to work with SACLANT in making arrangements for the visit.
