SUBJECT: Letter of Congratulations to New Norwegian Defense Minister -- ACTION MEMORANDUM

I recommend you sign the attached congratulatory letter to the new Defense Minister of Norway, Rolf Hansen (Tab A).

Hansen, a member of the moderate or "traditional social democratic" wing of the Labor party, was appointed to the Defense post on 12 January by Prime Minister Odvar Nordli who was succeeding Trygve Bratteli. Hansen succeeds Alf Fostervoll who will return to his seat in the Storting.

Hansen has been Labor Party Chairman in Oslo. He has had considerable association with defense matters, having served on the party committee responsible for drafting the five-year defense plan. For fourteen years he served as an ombudsman in the Defense ministry. He is known as a strong supporter of NATO and is regarded as pro-US.
