SUBJECT: Mi 1 i tary Representation at the UN - **INFORMATION MEMORANDUM**

23 AUG 1976

U.S. military representation at the UN is provided by JCS. There are representatives from each Service at three-star level. These are additional duty positions, the MILREPS going to New York only as required. Each representative is desi'gnated by his Service Chief. Currently, the MILREPS are: Navy - Vice Admiral Moorer, DCNO; Army - Lieutenant General Vessey, DCSOPS; Air Force - Lieutenant General Boswell, Assistant Vice Chief of Staff.

Continuous representation is provided by Deputy Mi 1 i tary Representatives with a Colonel equivalent from each Service. They are housed in the Mission and support and advise the Ambassador. In addition, approximately three clerks support the Deputy Mi 1 i tary Representatives.

There is a UN Military Staff Committee composed of Chiefs of Staff of each permanent member of the Security Council. It meets every two weeks in fulfillment of Article 47 of the UN Charter related to peacekeeping efforts. This formal activity is usually handled by the resident Deputy Military Representative.

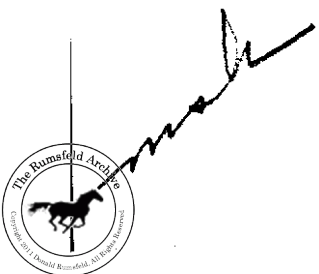

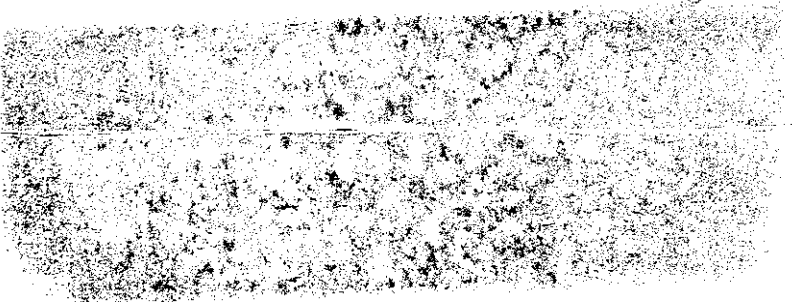
